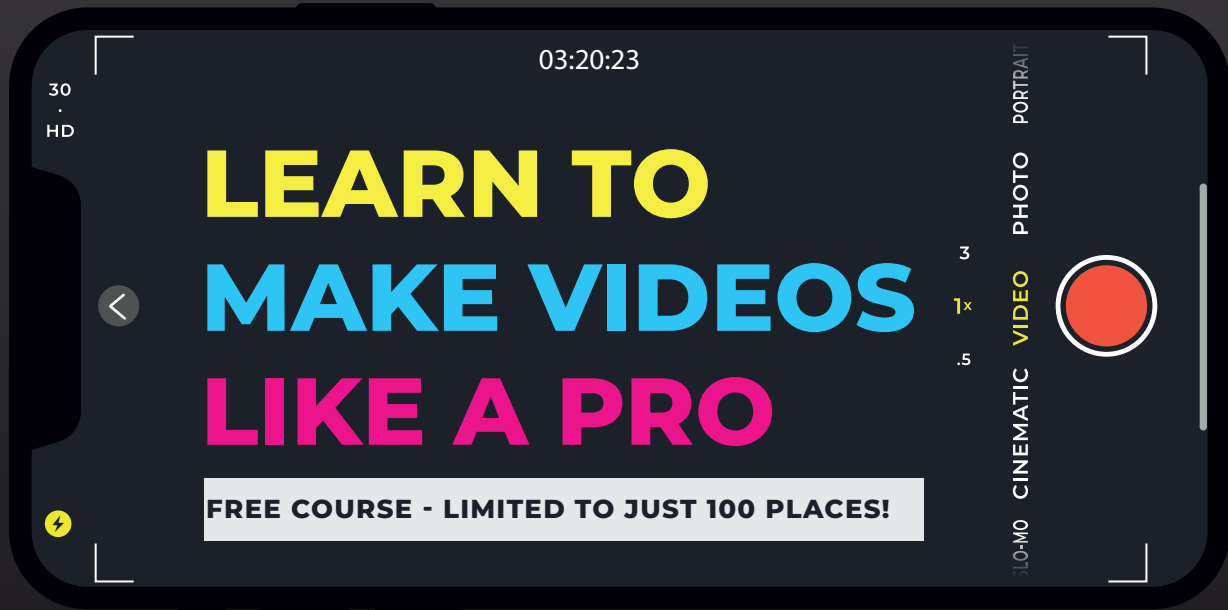


BFI SMARTPHONE VIDEO PRODUCTION FOR COMMUNITY CRICKET



Give your employees or volunteers all the skills required to create videos on their phone, and share all the stories from your cricket community online.

The free course is made up of two workshops, developed in partnership between the BFI (British Film Institute) and the ECB. Participants will learn how to shoot and edit high-quality video content perfect for your social media channels and website.

At the end of the training, each person will produce a short video which will be ready to use straight away. They'll also have the skills, knowledge, and confidence to keep producing new videos for years to come!
